

### Jerash and Ajloun Day Trip from the Dead Sea

- Pick Up Point / Starting from : Dead Sea Hotel
- Pick Up Time : 8.00 am
- Trip Duration : 08-10 Hours Approx. (Depends if Summer or Winter time)
- Trip Type : Private Tour by Air-conditioned vehicle
- Trip Runs : Every Day / Any Day



#### **From the Dead Sea to the Northern Heights:** Roman Ruins, Crusader Castles, and Galilee Views

Today, you will leave the lowest point on Earth and travel north to explore the lush landscapes and rich history of Northern Jordan.

Your journey begins at Jerash, nestled in the quiet Valley among the mountains of Gilead. This is the grandeur of Imperial Rome preserved in stone; explore its paved and colonnaded streets, magnificent theaters, the Oval Plaza, soaring temples, and Hadrians Arch. It is one of the most complete Roman sites outside of Italy.

Next, a short, scenic drive through beautiful pine forests and olive groves brings you to Ajloun. Here stands the impressive Al-Rabid Castle, a vital 12th-century fortress built by Saladin's lieutenants during the campaigns against the Crusaders.

Finally, you will proceed to Umm Qais, the ancient city that belonged to the famous Decapolis league. From this stunning vantage point, you will have an overwhelming panoramic view over the North Jordan Valley, the Golan Heights, and the tranquil Sea of Galilee.

After a full day of historical exploration, you will be comfortably transferred back to your hotel at the Dead Sea, Amman, or the airport.
